**Input Distribution (Cattle feed, mineral mixture and white phenyl) cum FMD awareness Programme cum Training on important diseases of cattle and their management
(Under DAPST)
Date: 21th November 2024**



An input distribution along with FMD awareness and training programme on important diseases of cattle and its management under DAPST was organized by ICAR-NIFMD at Barasahi Gram Panchayat of Khordha district, Odisha on 21. 11. 2024. The programme was conducted with a long-term vision for upliftment of scheduled tribe community. The programme was organized by ICAR-NIFMD including *Dr T. Das* (scientist) and *Dr. S. Mallick* along with 4 other contractual staffs of the institute. A total of 34 beneficiaries from ST community participated in the programme. Training on “*important diseases of cattle and their management*” was delivered. Significant diseases of cattle like bacterial (HS, BQ, Anthrax, calf scour), viral (FMD, LSD), parasitic (internal, external parasite, blood protozoa), mastitis etc. were discussed and their management, control, prevention, vaccination etc. were explained. Awareness was created regarding FMD clinical signs in different animal species, transmission, management, importance of vaccination, schedule of vaccination, deworming before vaccination, FMDV control, prevention of its transmission, supportive treatment, negative effects of FMD on animal and country, personal hygiene, cleanliness of animal and animal shed etc. and leaflets on FMD were distributed among them. During the programme, a total of 34 beneficiaries from ST community rearing

158 (cattle-102, goat-56) livestock were distributed with inputs such as white phenyl, mineral mixture (1.2 kg/ Pkt.), cattle feed (50 kg packet each) for improving livestock health and productivity.
